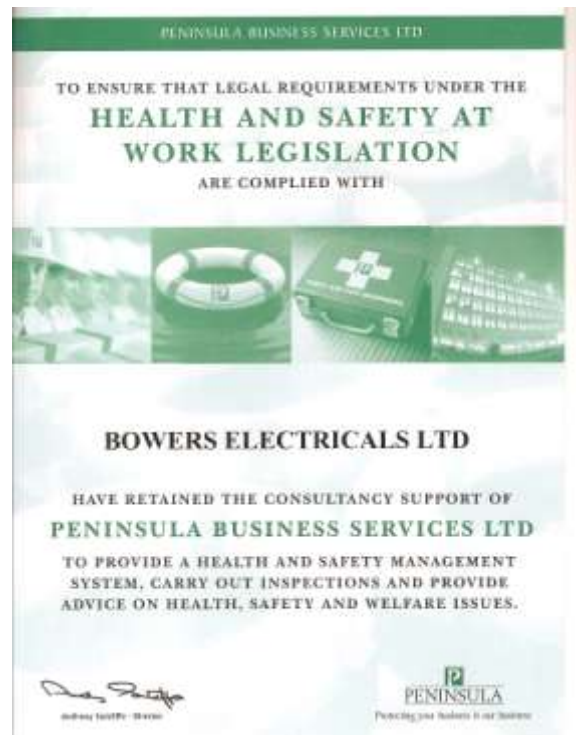
## Health & Safety
